

William E. Bryant Scholarships



Named for William E. Bryant, 33°, M.S.A., Past Commander-in-Chief of New Hampshire Consistory for 1999 and 2000, the Scholarship Program provides financial support for the continuing education of young men and women from New Hampshire Scottish Rite families and Masonic-related youth groups.

Eligibility:

The following criteria are used to determine the eligibility of applicants for the program:

- Be currently enrolled as a freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior at an accredited college or university.
- Have a minimum Grade Point Average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale. (Freshman scholarships will be distributed after an acceptable GPA is submitted, following the first semester.)
- Be one of the following:
 - The child or grandchild of a Scottish Rite Mason in the N.M.J.
 - A member of DeMolay, Rainbow, or Jobs Daughters in the N.M.J.

Complete the application online; print five copies of the application; and sign all copies on pages 3 and 6. Submit all 5 copies, with five copies of all supporting documentation to the appropriate Valley Secretary. Applicants should submit their application to the Valley providing for their eligibility. For instance, if a grandfather is providing eligibility, submit the application to his Valley. Likewise, if the father's Scottish Rite membership is providing eligibility, it will go to his Valley. If qualifying by membership in DeMolay, Rainbow, or Jobs Daughters, submit the forms to the Valley which covers the city or town where that organization meets.

Page 1 (this page) is the instruction page for the applicant, and does not need to be submitted. (Applicants who also meet the requirements for an Abbott Scholarship will be considered for that, as well). If an applicant qualifies for both scholarships, still submit only 5 copies of all supporting documentation with the application.

Applications must be received by the appropriate Valley Secretary by April 1.

Abbott Scholarships for Undergraduate Studies

Named for Leon M. Abbott, Sovereign Grand Commander from 1921 to 1932, the Scholarship Program provides financial support for the continuing undergraduate education of young men and women from Scottish Rite families and Masonic-related youth groups. Since 1951, more than \$15 million has been awarded to students from each state of the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction.

Eligibility: The following criteria are used to determine the eligibility of applicants for the program:

- A currently enrolled freshman, sophomore, junior or senior at an accredited college or university.
- A minimum grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale. (Freshman scholarships will be distributed after an acceptable GPA is submitted, following the first semester.)
- A child of a Scottish Rite Mason in the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction.
- A member of a youth organization sponsored by the Masonic fraternity in the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction.

Applicants should print the form, complete it, and mail it to the appropriate Valley secretary. Applicants should submit their application to their father's Valley.
