Starting with the 2006/2007 budget year the Ray Chase Scholarships will be funded by a line item in the budget. The amount to be voted by the Valley members as part of the budget.

This scholarship is open to any high school senior enrolling in undergraduate courses and/or any student regularly attending at a school of higher learning, to include Tech. schools, Junior colleges, colleges, and universities but preference will be given to at least one Dover High School student. Ray Chase lived in Dover. It would be expected that we would involve his widow in the presentations.

The applicant must be a Valley of Ports-Dover member, or a wife, son, daughter, brother, sister, grandchild, widow or orphan, of a member, or a graduate of the Seacoast Center, 32° Masonic Learning Centers for Children, Inc.

Application forms may be requested from the Valley secretary throughout the year but must be submitted to the Valley by April 15th to be considered for that years scholarship.

Scholarship payments will be made direct to the students in June or July.

This scholarship program may be amended, suspended, or canceled at any time by a majority vote of the Valley.
